"Strong Board, Strong Team: Better Board Behavior"

This workshop is designed for Intermediate level attendees with 4-6 years of experience although those with more or less experience will likely benefit from this nationally recognized speaker. MURP has applied for 1.5 CEUs.

To be effective, individual directors must understand their duties, rules of order for boards, and how to reach decisions. They must understand the source of their authority and its limitations. RONR provides guidance on rules of order for boards. Other sources provide detailed information on both legal and moral aspects of fiduciary duties of directors. The presentation will focus on teaching board authority, board business and board director duties to a board. Attendees will learn an approach to board structure and function, the director's role, and the rules for conducting business in large and small boards.
